Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for Imports via Savannah (Calendar Year)

Last updated: August 2020 (GPA Marketing)

Detail Summary:

- Northeast Asia was the largest trade lane for imports via Savannah during Calendar Year 2019 (CY19) and had the most growth between CY15 and CY19, increasing by 286,436 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between CY15 and CY19 were Southeast Asia (+102,225 TEUs), the Mediterranean (+66,805 TEUs), North Europe (+56,425 TEUs), and Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+51,474 TEUs).
