Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for Imports via Savannah (Fiscal Year)

Last updated: October 2020 (GPA Marketing)

Detail Summary:

- Northeast Asia was the largest trade lane for imports via Savannah during Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) and had the most growth between FY16 and FY20, increasing by 229,487 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between FY16 and FY20 were Southeast Asia (+124,202 TEUs), the Mediterranean (+55,597 TEUs), North Europe (+36,445 TEUs), and Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+30,895 TEUs).
