Five Year History for Top 10 Commodity Groups for Exports via Savannah (Fiscal Year)

Detail Summary:

- In Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20), Wood Pulp was the top export commodity group via Savannah.
- Wood Pulp also had the most growth between FY19 and FY20, increasing 31,539 TEUs.
- Of Savannah's top ten export commodity groups in FY20, Savannah had the highest market share among ports in the South Atlantic for seven.
