The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the “East River Terminal Dock Refurbishments” project.

Bids for proposed work will be received up to **3:00 P.M., December 22, 2020**. The bid opening will be public.

The proposed work consists of extending the reinforced concrete deck overlay South throughout Shed 2 and North beyond the existing expansion joint with two existing columns encased in concrete. The overlay will also extend east to the two existing hoppers with their foundations reconstructed and the existing fence modified to accommodate elevated overlay. Three existing access Overhead Doors are to be raised to provide adequate clearance for customer vehicles. The Valve Room man doors are to be removed and sealed with CMU block. Exterior man doors are to be removed, raised, and modified to swing out. Existing compromised concrete piles shall be repaired with Prefabricated Fiber Reinforced Polymer (FRP) pile jackets and filled with grout. Reinforcing steel shall be added to maintain structural integrity of the compromised piles. Additionally, vertical dowels are proposed to be drilled/post installed into the existing deck and capitals at select piles.

Bid must be accompanied by a bid security equal to 10 percent of bid sum. If a construction contract is awarded, successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each equal in amount to contract sum.

Interested parties are invited to attend a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting that will convene at 10:00 A.M., November 24, 2020, in Georgia Ports Authority, Mayor’s Point Terminal, 1100 Bay Street, Brunswick, Georgia 31520. Bidders will have an opportunity to conduct an examination of the project site after the pre-bid meeting. Bidders may conduct additional examinations by contacting
