## Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for <a href="Imports">Imports</a> via Savannah (Calendar Year)

## **Detail Summary:**

- Northeast Asia was the largest trade lane for imports via Savannah during Calendar Year 2020 (CY20) and had the most growth between CY16 and CY20, increasing by 285,722 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between CY16 and CY20 were Southeast Asia (+165,246 TEUs), the Mediterranean (+64,491 TEUs), Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+36,122 TEUs), and North Europe (+31,707 TEUs).
