The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the Colonel's Island Terminal – Berth 1 Fender Replacement project. Bids for proposed work will be received up to **3:00 P.M., July 1, 2021**. The bid opening will be public.

The proposed work consists of the removal of two (2) floating foam filled fenders and four (4) rubber cone fenders with H-pile supported steel frontal panels from the main dock and removal of rubber cone fenders with steel H-pile supported frontal panels from three (3) breasting dolphins. The removed fenders will be replaced with ten (10) rubber cone fenders with steel frontal panels (no H-piles). Fender removal and new fender installation will be sequenced and coordinated with GPA vessel operations. The project is located at the Colonel's Island Terminal, Brunswick, Georgia.

The estimated construction cost of the project is between \$750,000 and \$1,500,000.

Bid must be accompanied by a bid security equal to 10 percent of bid sum. If a construction contract is awarded, successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each equal in amount to contract sum.

Interested parties are invited to attend a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting that will convene at 10:00 A.M., June 21, 2021, in the GPA's Mayors Point Administrative office, located at 100 Gloucester Street, Brunswick, GA.
