The Uniform Intermodal Interchange and Facilities Access Agreement, or UIIA, is a standard industry contract between intermodal truckers/drayage companies and water and rail carriers (equipment providers). The UIIA was developed as a means of achieving a degree of uniformity in the interchange process.

The UIIA covers liability and other issues related to the interchange of intermodal equipment (i.e. containers, chassis, etc.) between the two parties. It drastically reduces the paperwork burden for all parties involved by eliminating having to sign individual interchange contracts with each equipment provider that is participating in this agreement. It also reduces the number of insurance filings for the motor carrier to provide proof of insurance. Only one certificate must be issued to the UIIA and this information is then disseminated to the individual equipment providers by our office. The UIIA currently has 5,400 motor carriers, 45 water carriers, 6 railroads and 2 leasing companies that participate in the program.

SCAC CODES:

The Standard Carrier Alpha Code (SCAC®) is a unique two-to-four-letter code used to identify transportation companies. NMFTA developed the SCAC identification codes in the mid 1960's to facilitate computerization in the transportation industry.

CREDENTIALING INSTRUCTIONS:

Company Registration:

Log on to www.gaports.com
Look under "Quick Reference"
Click on "Credentials"
Click on "Registration"
Complete the form and submit. You will create your own username and password. Be sure all email addresses listed are correct. Representative is not who is getting the badge, but who is authorized to enter information.

Badge Request:

Once approval is received, follow the steps below:
Log on to www.gaports.com
Click on "Safety and Security"
Click on "Credentials"
Click on "login"
Enter username and password
Click on the top left badge request button. Complete and submit the form. You will receive an immediate message of receipt. Bring 2 of the below listed forms of

identification (one must be a picture ID) and come to the GPA Credentialing Center to be processed for your badge.

GPA Credentialing:

To obtain a GPA Credential, each person must have 2 valid forms of identification from the list (required). One must be a recent picture ID (required).
