The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the Mayor's Point Terminal –Fender Replacement project. Bids for proposed work will be received up to **3:30 P.M., March 1, 2022**. The bid opening will be public.

The proposed project consists of providing all materials, equipment, and labor required to replace the existing fender system at the Mayor's Point Terminal Berth. Specifically, the project consists of all work required to remove the existing rubber arch fenders, steel fender piles and timber chocks and install new rubber fender leg elements, steel fender piles with a UHMW facing, and timber chocks.
