Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for Imports via Savannah (Calendar Year)

Last updated: May 2022 (GPA Marketing)

Detail Summary:

- Northeast Asia was the largest trade lane for imports via Savannah during Calendar Year 2021 (CY21) and had the most growth between CY17 and CY21, increasing by 403,620 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between CY17 and CY21 were Southeast Asia (+248,826 TEUs), the Mediterranean (+93,432 TEUs), Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+90,122 TEUs), and Eastern Europe (+13,002 TEUs).
