The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the “IAP Parcel Upgrades (Parcels 4A/B, 8 & 9)” project.

Bids for proposed work will be received up to **3:00 PM, March 3, 2023**. The bid opening will be public.

The proposed work consists of the removal and replacement of approximately 52 acres of concrete and asphalt pavements, site grading to improve drainage, and installation and maintenance of erosion control measures. Demolished concrete pavements are to be crushed on site by the contractor and recycled into the Graded Aggregate Base for this project. The project is located at the Colonel's Island Terminal, Brunswick, Georgia.

Bidders will have an opportunity to conduct an examination of the project site after the pre-bid meeting.
