

## Port of Savannah & Brunswick

### Total Annual Tonnage for Calendar Years 2018 through 2022

Last updated: May 2023 (GPA Marketing)

#### Detail Summary:

- The Georgia Ports Authority marked record volumes in Calendar Year 2022 (CY22) in total tonnage, container tonnage, container throughput, gate moves, and breakbulk tonnage.
- Total tonnage grew 15% from 36.9 million short tons in CY18 to 42.4 million short tons in CY22.
- Container tonnage comprised 88% of total tonnage during CY22.
