Detail Summary:

- The Georgia Ports Authority handled a record 775,564 units of autos and machinery in Calendar Year 2023 (CY23), an increase of 15.6% over the previous year.
- Total tonnage receded 0.7% from 38.5 million short tons in CY19 to 38.3 million short tons in CY23.
- Container tonnage comprised 88% of total tonnage during CY23.
