Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for Imports via Savannah (Calendar Year)

Last updated: May 2024 (GPA Marketing)

Detail Summary:

- Southeast Asia was the fastest growing trade lane for imports via Savannah between Calendar Year 2019 (CY19) and CY23, increasing by 166,425 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between CY19 and CY23 were Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+56,387 TEUs), Mediterranean (+15,378 TEUs), Africa (+7,968 TEUs), and West Coast of South America (+5,228 TEUs).
