Total Annual Tonnage for Fiscal Years 2020 through 2024

Detail Summary:

- The Georgia Ports Authority handled a record 875,950 units of autos and machinery in Fiscal Year 2024 (FY24), an increase of 21.1% over the previous year.
- Total tonnage increased 8% from 37.8 million short tons in FY20 to 40.9 million short tons in FY24.
- Container tonnage comprised 88% of total tonnage during FY24.
