

## Port of Savannah & Brunswick

### Total Annual Tonnage for Calendar Years 2020 through 2024

Last updated: March 2025 (GPA Marketing)

#### Detail Summary:

- The Georgia Ports Authority handled a record 900,735 units of autos and machinery in Calendar Year 2024 (CY24), an increase of 16% over the previous year.
- Total tonnage increased 10% from 38.4 million short tons in CY20 to 42.1 million short tons in CY24.
- Container tonnage comprised 88% of total tonnage during CY24.
