The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the “GCT Gate 1 Access Modifications” project.

Bids for proposed work will be received up to **3:00 P.M., January 13, 2026**. The bid opening will be public.

The project will include delegated design and construction of buildings and canopies; building demolition, construction of new paved yards areas and roads; railroad track crossings; storm drainage distribution and ditches; water, sewer, and electrical distributions and security technologies; fencing, barrier, guardrail, striping and signage work. Majority of construction will take place outside Garden City Terminal’s secure perimeter. The project is located in Garden City, Georgia.

The Architect/Engineer is AECOM located at 115 Main St, Garden City, GA 31408.

Bidding Documents will be on file for review in the offices of the Architect/ Engineer after **November 12, 2025**. Complete sets of Bidding Documents in a PDF format will be made available from an Internet site maintained by AECOM.

Bid must be accompanied by a bid security equal to 10 percent of bid sum. If a construction contract is awarded, successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each equal in amount to contract sum.

Interested parties are invited to attend a **non-mandatory** pre-bid meeting that will convene at **2:30 P.M., November 12, 2025, in the Administrative Conference Room, located at 2 Main Street, Garden City, Georgia 31408**. Bidders will have an opportunity to conduct an examination of the project site after the pre-bid meeting.
