Port Wentworth Downtown Truck Restrictions – Effective July 1, 2026

The City of Port Wentworth has announced a local initiative to remove tractor trailer traffic from Coastal Highway (State Route 25) within the city to enable more downtown revitalization.

Motor carriers are advised that the City of Port Wentworth will prohibit tractor-trailer traffic through downtown beginning **July 1, 2026**.

- The restriction applies to **Coastal Highway (State Route 25)** between **Grange Road** and **Bonnybridge Road**.
- Tractor-trailers will not be permitted to travel through downtown Port Wentworth once enforcement begins and may receive a citation for driving through this area.
- Truck traffic traveling from South Carolina will be required to turn right onto Bonnybridge Road and proceed to Highway 21.
- Only traffic destined for warehouse operator, DSI, may continue past Bonnybridge Road to access the facility; however, trucks are not permitted to cross the overpass — if trucks cross the overpass a ticket and fine will be given.
- Truck traffic traveling on Grange Road will no longer be allowed to turn left onto Coastal Highway.
- Only local delivery traffic with a permit will be allowed on South Coastal Highway, between Bonnybridge Road and Grange Road.

Gate 5

To enter Gate 5 at Garden City Terminal, drivers are advised to use Jimmy DeLoach Parkway to Grange Road and right on Main Street.

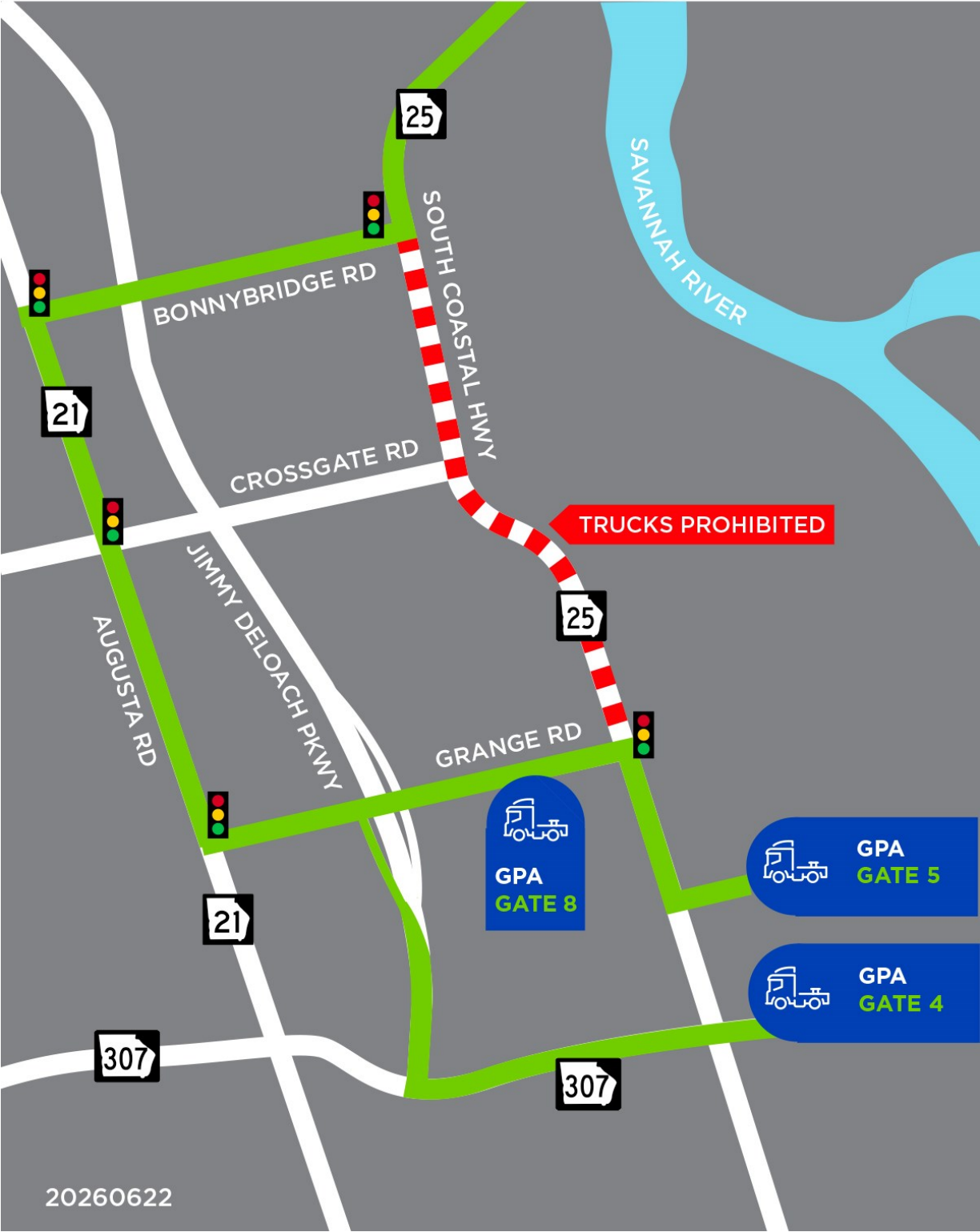
Gate 4

To enter Gate 4 drivers should use Jimmy DeLoach Parkway to Bourne Avenue.

The Georgia Ports Authority is working with our partners to help communicate approved routing and minimize disruption to port operations.
