Dave Cyr is the Chief Executive Officer and a Founding Partner of Parrish Construction Group, which over the years has scaled significantly becoming one of Georgia's premier commercial general contractors and consistently earning national recognition on the *Engineering News-Record* (ENR) Top 400 Contractors list.

A native of Central Florida, Dave began his career in the construction industry immediately after graduating from the M.E. Rinker, Sr. School of Building Construction at the University of Florida in 1985. He spent nine years managing multi-story concrete frame projects for a major Atlanta-based general contractor before relocating to Middle Georgia to help launch a startup venture. In 1995, he co-founded Parrish Construction Group, where he remains a principal stakeholder and, along with the Executive Leadership Team established in 2022, he continues to be actively involved in providing executive leadership and vision for the company.

Beyond his corporate responsibilities, Dave has also been consistently involved in state-wide public service.

Appointed to the Georgia Ports Authority Board of Directors by Governor Brian Kemp in 2021 and re-appointed to a second term in 2025. He currently serves as Secretary-Treasurer.

Selected by Governor Sonny Perdue in 2005 as a foundational Director for Georgia's newly formed General Contractor Licensing Board, serving eight years, concluding his tenure as Chairman.

Elected to the National Board of Governors for Associated General Contractors of America (AGC) in 2018, after serving a decade on the Board of Directors for AGC Georgia, leading the chapter as President from 2013 to 2014.

Elected as a Director in 2018 for ComTrust AGC and now serves as the Vice Chairman of the Board for this Mutual Captive Insurance Company.

Mr. Cyr and his wife reside in Hayneville, Georgia and have two grown sons with families of their own.
