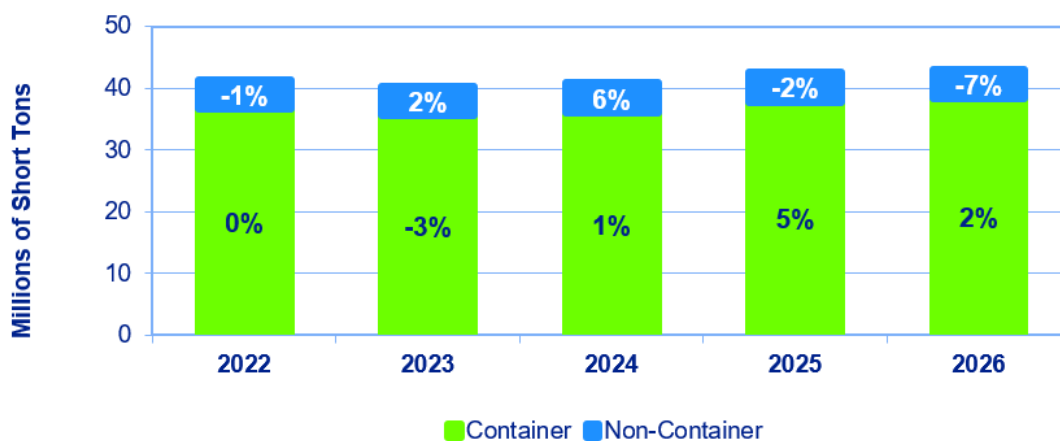
Detail Summary:

- The Georgia Ports Authority marked record volumes in Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) in total tonnage, container tonnage, and Appalachian Regional Port rail.
- Total tonnage increased 4% from 41.3 million short tons in FY22 to 42.9 million short tons in FY26.
- Container tonnage comprised 90% of total tonnage during FY26.
