Detail Summary:

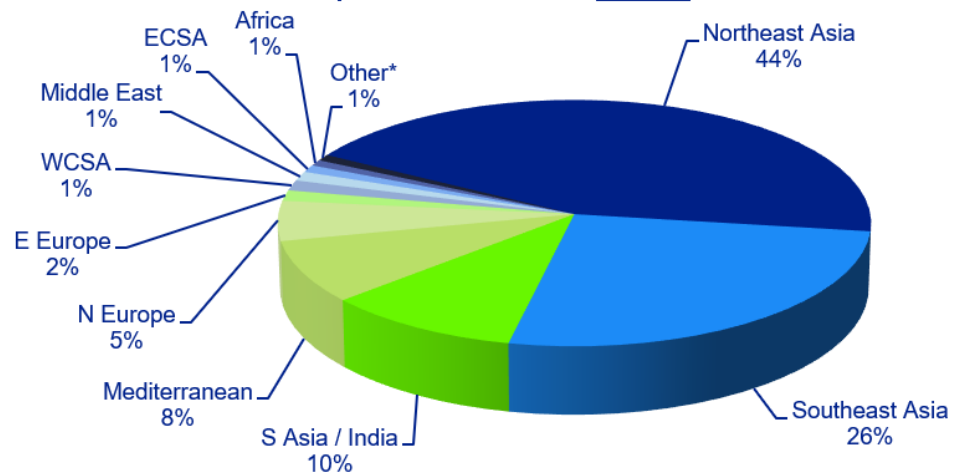
- Southeast Asia was the fastest growing trade lane for imports via Savannah between Fiscal Year 2022 (FY22) and FY26, increasing by 243,467 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between FY22 and FY26 were Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+41,082 TEUs), Mediterranean (+16,492 TEUs), North Europe (+15,180 TEUs), and Middle East (+9,659 TEUs).
